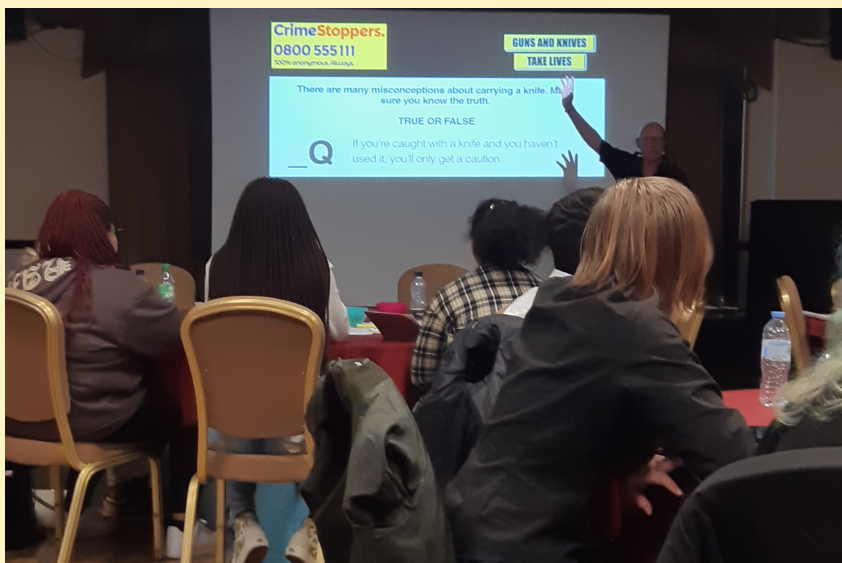
So far, the group have advised the police on Dark Nights / Bonfire night, Safeguarding Awareness and much more!

South Yorkshire Police:

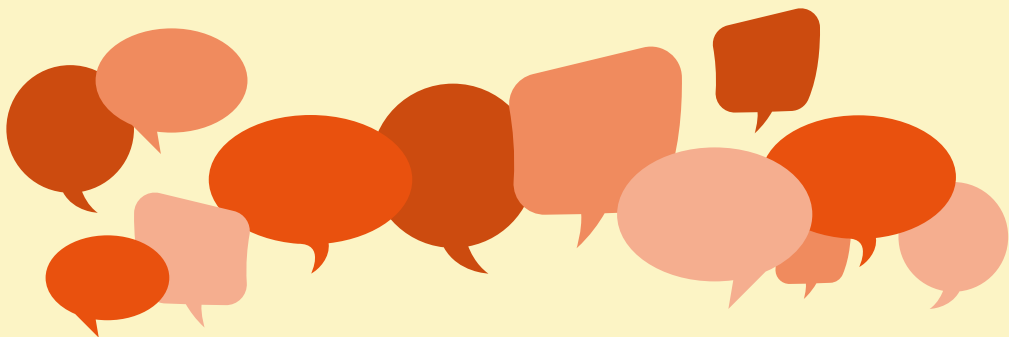
- Have the opportunity to hear directly from young people what matters to them
